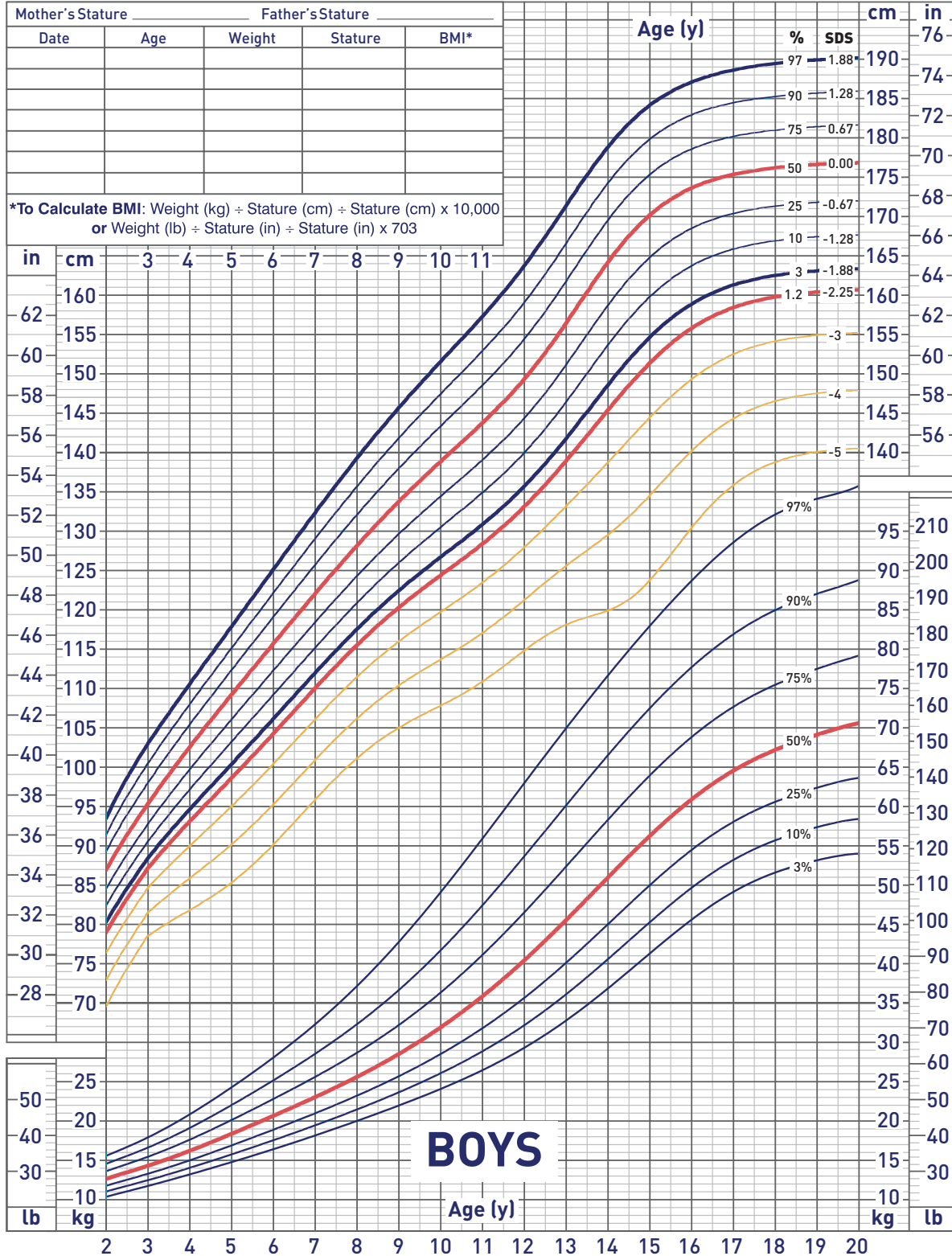

## Growth Chart 2 to 20 Years: Boys



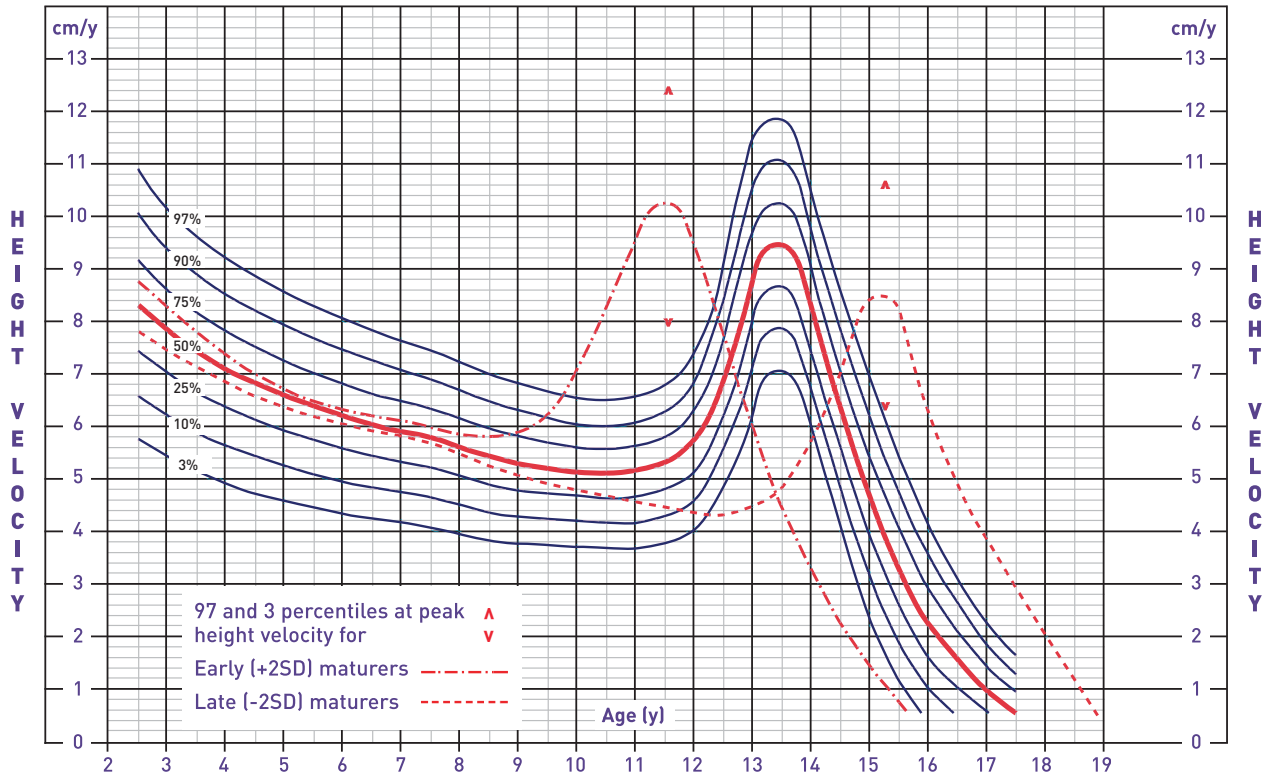

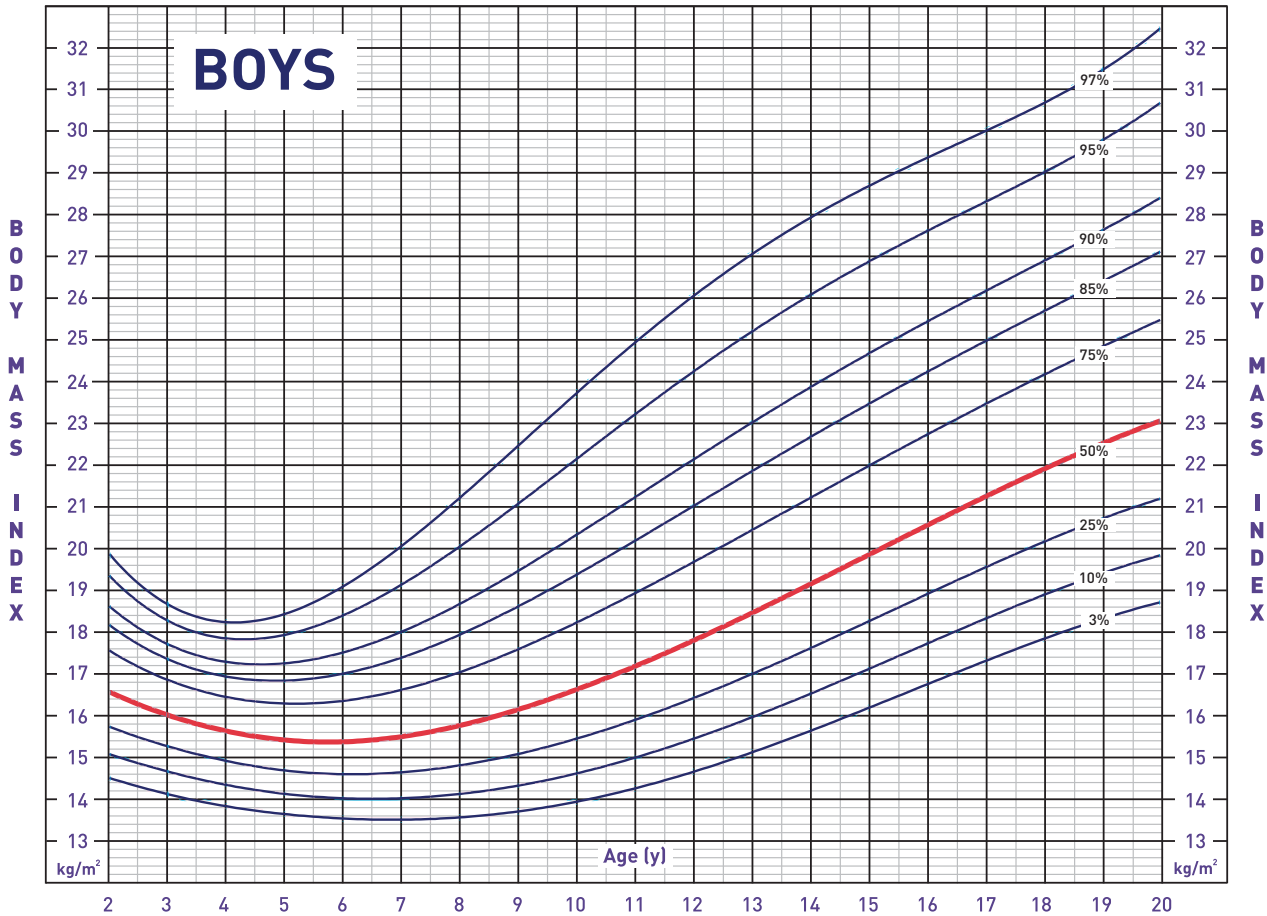

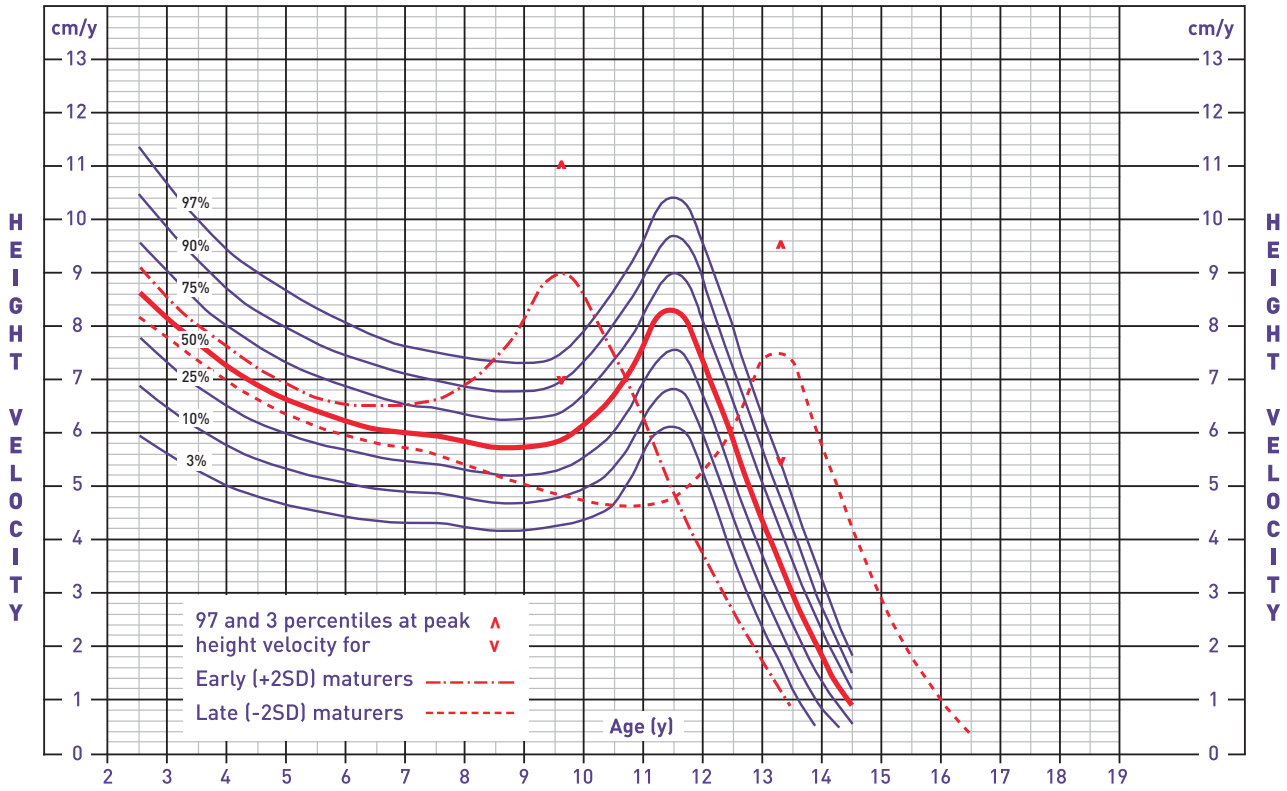
